



APPROVAL PREREQUISITES FOR THE PROVIDERS OF CO-PILOT RIDES AS PART OF THE TOURIST RIDES ON THE NORDSCHLEIFE OF THE NÜRBURGRING

Prerequisites for companies who wish to commercially transport passengers within the tourist rides:

- > No police record of road traffic offences (extract from the central traffic register).
- > No serious violations of the Nordschleife Driving Regulations in the past 3 years.
- > Business licence and sufficient insurance (vehicle insurance has to cover “commercial passenger transport as part of the tourist rides”) must be presented to Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG (NG).
- > The vehicles used must be in perfect technical condition at all times; technical checks on all days of operation must be documented. If requested, NG must be granted access to the documentation of said checks. Unannounced technical inspections by an independent organisation (e.g. TÜV) must be permitted and paid for by the provider.
- > Only road legal vehicles may be used.
- > A maximum of two vehicles per provider may be used. In the event of a technical failure of one of the two aforementioned vehicles a replacement vehicle may be used after notification to the NG track management.
- > Only suitable personnel may be used to carry out the rides (see section 2).
- > No time keeping of any kind is to be taken. At no time the focus may be on achieving a certain lap time. Communication of lap times for promotional purposes in connection with the co-pilot rides is not permitted. Safety must be the top priority at all times.
- > Payment of an appropriate license fee to the NG of at least € 20,000 per year, payable in each case before the start of the season after receipt of invoice; in return, the NG will provide free of charge up to two vehicle-related season cards for the tourist rides on the Nordschleife. These are earmarked for a specific purpose and may only be used to carry out the co-pilot rides.
- > NG will provide all licensees with space in the sales container on the parking lot “Zufahrt Nordschleife” (Nordschleife access road) to handle customer service, sales and instructions for the duration of the licence contract. The exact space will be as-signed by NG in writing once the sales container is set up. Each licensee will also be provided with two parking spaces nearby. Structural modifications are not permitted. Advertising measures on site beyond the space provided by NG at the sales container plus two beach flags require separate approval by NG.



APPROVAL PREREQUISITES FOR THE PROVIDERS OF CO-PILOT RIDES AS PART OF THE TOURIST RIDES ON THE NORDSCHLEIFE OF THE NÜRBURGRING

Prerequisites for drivers who commercially transport passengers within the tourist rides:

- > The licensee is obliged to use only those drivers who are able to meet the requirements both physically and in terms of their experience. Demonstrable, extensive experience on the Nürburgring Nordschleife, which can be proved either from motorsport experience or from professional involvement, includes, for example:
 - > Several years of work as an instructor at driver trainings on the Nürburgring Nordschleife
 - > Verifiable multi-year motorsport experience, especially verifiable experience driving on the Nordschleife, for instance based on participation in VLN races or the 24-Hour Race. Participation in Regularity Runs and the like is not sufficient.
 - > Test drivers / test engineers with verifiable training and experience on the Nordschleife
 - > Holders Permit A Nordschleife
- > No police record of road traffic offences (extract from the central traffic register).
- > Valid driving licence. This must be presented to Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG by all drivers.
- > Minimum age 27 years.
- > No serious violations of the Nordschleife Driving Regulations in the past 3 years.

General prerequisites:

- > The driving regulations of the tourist rides must be observed at all times.
- > Licensee must ensure that the tourist rides are not affected by the provision of co-pilot rides; in particular, the change of participants must not obstruct access to the Nordschleife and traffic on the Nordschleife parking lot.

In case of violations of the contractual terms, NG shall be entitled to exercise its property rights and prohibit the licensee as well as the driver from using the track at any time. Moreover, the licence may be revoked immediately in case of serious or repeated noncompliance with safety-related requirements, which means the licensee will be excluded from using the tracks for commercial purposes. In case of violations of the aforementioned Licencing Prerequisites, NG will withdraw authorisation only after repeated infringement and prior warning. Particularly serious violations, however, may result in the immediate withdrawal of authorisation. If a licence is revoked, the licensee is not entitled to a refund of the licence fee.
